Fort Collins, CO- A homeowner, her three dogs and another occupant escaped safely after a fire was discovered in the garage of her residence today in east Fort Collins. Firefighters arrived quickly to find flames had fully-engulfed the interior of the garage on the south side of the residence. The rapidly growing fire was impinging on a wood fence and threatening a neighbor's house also. Even with the large amount of fire, crews were able to contain the fire within the garage, thereby holding damage to the living space at a minimum. The garage interior was completely destroyed however the living space of the residence sustained only minor smoke damage.

Firefighters had to cut two holes in the roof to extinguish fire in void spaces and completed other tasks such as a search of the residence for any potential persons trapped, which proved negative, and removal of smoke from the building. Two cats were found during the search and removed from the residence uninjured.

Red Cross responded to assist the occupants with immediate food and clothing needs.

PFA Investigators are working to determine the origin and cause. No additional information is available at this time.
