Fort Collins, CO- Firefighters responded early this morning to a report of smoke and flames with explosions from a vehicle fire on Colorado State University property. The first engine arrived to find two vehicles fully involved, with flames impinging on two others a building and a large natural gas line for the building. Firefighters were able to limit damage on the building and gas line, however two vehicles were destroyed and the two others suffered moderate damage.

Assisting agencies are CSU Police Department, Poudre Valley Ambulance Service and Xcel Energy.

PFA and CSUPD Investigators are working to determine the origin and cause. The fire is considered suspicious. No additional information is available at this time.
