Fort Collins, CO- Just after 1300 hours today Poudre Emergency Communications Center received a report of a male approximately 40'-50' up in a tree and unconscious. Additional information given was that the male, in his 30's, was cutting tree branches when a branch possibly came down and hit him. Firefighters using a cherry picker type lift reached the patient and confirmed he was deceased. No other workers or civilians were injured. At this time this incident is considered an industrial accident.

Larimer County Coroner will determine the cause of death and name of the decedent.
