Fort Collins, CO – Poudre Emergency Communications Center received a 911 call from the manager of the park reporting flames and lots of black smoke from the above address. The four residents, who have been displaced, were not at home when the fire started.

Poudre Fire Authority crews arrived to find fire and smoke coming from a single-wide manufactured home. Firefighters immediately initiated an aggressive interior attack on the fire located in a front bedroom. They also performed additional jobs such as a search for potential occupants still inside and ventilated the building of smoke and hot fire gases using a fan. They were able to bring the incident under control within eleven minutes, but not before the front bedroom suffered heavy fire damage and the entire residence suffered significant smoke damage.

The origin has been determined to be the front bedroom and the cause was accidental due to an electrical fault.

The Red Cross responded to assist with food, clothing and baby supplies. The residents have no insurance.
