*All of the minors transported to PVH have been treated and released. They reported symptoms such as headache, nausea, vomiting and watery eyes.

*After extensive testing, crews were unable to determine a source. All PFA resources left the scene after building ventilation operations were complete.

*PFA Hazardous Material Technicians may return tomorrow to assist again in a search for the source.

*As of 1800 hours the building has been turned back over to Poudre School District. Employees will remain on scene all night to monitor.
