Fort Collins, CO –Residents were not home when a fire started in their townhome last night, but their neighbors on either side of them were able to escaped unharmed. Firefighters arrived to find fire and smoke coming from at least two windows on the second floor of a three story, wood-frame, multi-family building.

Firefighters used multiple hose teams in a successful aggressive attack to stop the flames from spreading to the neighboring units in the building. Firefighters also conducted searches for any occupants possibly still inside the homes, but found none, however three dogs were safely removed; one cat is still unaccounted for. In addition, firefighters also ventilated heat, smoke and fire gases from the residences. The entire building was evacuated as a precaution.

The fire origin and cause are under investigation and no additional information is available at this time.

Assisting agencies were Fort Collins Light & Power, Police Services and Poudre Valley Hospital Ambulance Services.
