Fort Collins, CO –Four residents had to flee this morning as two mobile homes burned during an early morning fire in LaPorte. Two residents in each home were able to escape unharmed. When PFA firefighters arrived they found the two single-wide mobile homes, an attached shed and outdoor storage area on fire.

Firefighters used multiple hose teams in a successful aggressive attack to stop the flames from spreading to other nearby exposures. Firefighters also conducted searches for any occupants possibly still inside the homes, but found none. In addition, firefighters also ventilated heat, smoke and fire gases from the residences. Nearby homes were evacuated as a precaution. Both homes were destroyed.

Red Cross has been contacted to assist with immediate needs.

The fire origin and cause are under investigation and no additional information is available at this time.
