Fort Collins, CO – A Poudre Fire Authority Investigator has determined the origin of this fire to be a bedroom. The cause of this fire is accidental; child playing with a lighter.

Upon further investigation it was found that a 5 year-old girl was lighting paper on fire with a cigarette lighter while in her bedroom. The mother was asleep at the time and discovered the fire after the daughter had reported it to her. The mother, daughter and a 3 year-old son escaped unharmed.

Poudre Fire Authority would like to remind everyone that children are responsible for at least 50% of intentionally set fires in the United States. There are different reasons that children set fires, a large part of which is curiosity.
