Fort Collins, CO- Firefighters were called to a fire just after 11:00 pm last night at the Fox Bar in south Fort Collins. The first units arrived to find the fire had already broken through the roof in the rear of a one-story, wood-frame building. Firefighters attacked the fire from the inside and then the roof in order to stop its spread through the attic. The main fire was quickly knocked down however it still gave firefighters a challenge while running through hidden void spaces. A hole was cut in the roof to access the last part of fire to be extinguished. A second alarm was called to provide additional help and appropriate staffing.

Firefighters also performed a search of the building to ensure nobody was trapped. It is not known if the business was open and operating at the time of the fire.

PFA investigators are working to determine the origin and cause. No additional information is available at this time.
