Fort Collins, CO- Just before 0230 hours this morning firefighters responded to what was reported as a fire to the back of a house. Upon arrival of the first units they found a fire had indeed involved the back of the one story, single-family, wood frame residence and had already spread inside. Firefighters entered the building through the front and found heavy fire conditions in the back half. As the fire was being attacked from the interior firefighters also searched for occupants to ensure nobody was trapped. The occupant had escaped prior to the arrival of responders.

The fire damaged at least 50% of the interior with the remainder suffering extensive heat and smoke damage.

PFA investigators determined the origin to be in the area of an exterior light fixture at the rear of the building. The cause has been determined to be accidental; electrical in nature. No additional information is available at this time.

Assisting agencies included Fort Collins Light & Power, Police Services, Poudre Valley Hospital Ambulance and Red Cross.
