Fort Collins, CO – Poudre Fire Authority responded to a reported garage fire just before 11:30 p.m. at the above address. Firefighters arrived to find a large amount of fire and smoke coming from an attached garage of a one-story, single-family, wood-framed dwelling. They also found that the two occupants had escaped, however one was transported to a local hospital with unspecified injuries.

Firefighters immediately initiated an aggressive interior attack on the fire in an attempt to keep it from spreading into the residence. Crews were successful with this; however the fire also spread to the attic space causing damage before it could be stopped. At the same time firefighters also performed additional jobs such as rescuing three pets that were located in the basement, along with ventilating the building of smoke and hot fire gases. They were able to bring the incident under control quickly, but not before the garage suffered heavy fire damage, including a roof collapse. The living area of the residence suffered significant smoke damage.

The origin has been determined to be in the garage and the cause is under investigation.

The Red Cross responded to assist.
