Fort Collins, CO – A fire at a Scotch Pines Apartments in Fort Collins is under investigation tonight after being extinguished by fire crews from Poudre Fire Authority. Poudre Fire Authority was initially called to smoke detectors sounding in a second floor apartment at this location. Crews were able to trace the source of the smoke to a smoldering fire in a first floor unit that had consumed some furnishings and computer equipment. The occupant of the apartment was not home at the time of the fire. Crews were unable to rescue two cats that were inside the apartment and were overcome by smoke from the fire. The fire displaced the occupant who was assisted with alternative housing for the evening.
