- Code Issue: Identify the specific code section for which the Code Modification Request and Alternative Methods and materials is proposed.
- Discussion/Justification: Provide rationale and supporting information such as technical data, engineering calculations, results of actual field tests, requirements or allowances in other model codes, etc. that provide the basis for PFA to accept the request. Proposed design documents (i.e., architectural or engineering plans) and supporting information listed above should be attached to the requests as needed to clarify proposed request.
- Conclusion: Provide a summary statement such as "In my/our professional opinion. The proposed code modification/alternate method of construction/materials meets the intent of the Codes and provides a level of safety equivalent to, or better than that requested by the Code."
